The Ballet and Movement School (TBAMS) aims to provide a safe and supportive learning environment in which students can focus and discover the beauty and discipline of ballet. In order to achieve this goal, we ask that each TBAMS student and parent commit to this code of conduct.

Code of Conduct

- TBAMS students and parents treat instructors and other students and parents with respect and courtesy.
- TBAMS students and parents respect the property of TBAMS and the personal property of others. TBAMS parents should not interrupt class or rehearsals.
- Foul language is prohibited
- In general, older students and adults should set a good example for the younger kids. Repeated misconduct will affect a student's promotion and participation in TBAMS productions. Students who regularly violate TBAMS Code of Conduct and Policies may be dismissed from TBAMS.
- Chewing gum and other candies during class is prohibited
- Ballet slippers are only to be worn inside the ballet studio, please provide your child a change of shoes for before and after class
- For ballet classes, please provide your child coverups to wear outside before and after class
- Please use the bathroom before class, have your kid use the bathroom before class

Late arrivals and Absences: Students should arrive properly attired and on time. A student who wants to enter class after it starts, should wait until

the combination is finished and ask for permission to join class. Due to risk of injury, students who arrive more than 15 minutes late may be required observe the class. Please report your absences.

Missed Classes: Classes need to be made up within the same session in the dancer's current level or the level below. Also, neither refunds nor credits will be given for missed classes.

Cell phones, Electronic Devices and other distractions: Students should turn off their cell phones and other personal electronics. Please put them away while at TBAMS and at the theatre. It is important to remain focused on appropriate ballet activities.

TBAMS is not responsible for lost, stolen or broken items.

Internet Use: TBAMS is not responsible for student postings on Facebook.com, Instagram, Twitter, Snapchat or other social networking websites.

Food: Eating is not allowed in the studio. Students may eat in the lobby or outside and must clean up after themselves. Liquids should be emptied before being put in the trash can. There will be no water breaks during classes, but students are allowed to bring water to drink before, after and between classes.
